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EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

EYE CONTACT: FLUSH WITH WATER FOR AT LEAST FIFTEEN MINUTES. CALL A PHYSICIAN. SKIN CONTACT: REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING AND WASH EXPOSED AREA WITH SOAP AND WATER. INHALATION: REMOVE TO FRESH AIR. IF NOT BREATHING, GIVE ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION, PREFERABLY MOUTH-TO-MOUTH. IF BREATHING DIFFICULTY PERSISTS OR OCCURS LATER, CONSULT A PHYSICIAN. IN THE UNLIKELY EVENT OF INGESTION DRINK A GLASS OF WATER AND CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.

===== SECTION VII - PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE =====

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

VENTILATE AREA. PREVENT SKIN CONTACT AND BREATHING OF VAPOR. CONFINE AND REMOVE WITH INERT ABSORBENT MATERIALS. DO NOT ALLOW MATERIAL TO CONTAMINATE GROUND WATER.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD:

DISPOSE OF ABSORBED MATERIAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS. DO NOT INCINERATE IN CLOSE CONTAINERS.

PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN HANDLING AND STORING:

OBSERVE LABEL PRECAUTIONS. KEEP CLOSURES TIGHT WHEN NOT IN USE. STORE IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION TO PREVENT LEAKAGE. WASH THOROUGHLY AFTER HANDLING AND BEFORE EATING OR SMOKING. DO NOT EXCEED STORAGE BETWEEN 40 Deg.F AND 120 Deg.F KEEP AND STORE OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

OTHER PRECAUTIONS:

DO NOT SAND, FLAME CUT, BRAZE OR WELD DRY COATING WITHOUT WEARING A NIOSH/MSHA APPROVED RESPIRATOR OR APPROPRIATE VENTILATION.

===== SECTION VIII - CONTROL MEASURES =====

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION:

FOR BRUSH AND ROLLER APPLICATION, RESPIRATORY PROTECTION IS NOT NORMALLY REQUIRED. FOR SPRAY APPLICATION, A PROPERLY FITTED VAPOR/PARTICULATE NIOSH/MSHA APPROVED RESPIRATOR IS RECOMMENDED.

VENTILATION:

SUFFICIENT IN PATTERN AND VOLUME TO KEEP VAPORS BELOW APPLICABLE OSHA REQUIREMENTS.

PROTECTIVE GLOVES: SOLVENT IMPERVIOUS GLOVES.

EYE PROTECTION: GOGGLES OR SAFETY GLASSES WITH SIDE SHIELD.

OTHER PROTECTIVE CLOTHING OR EQUIPMENT:

SAFETY SHOWER AND EYE BATH. COVERALLS ARE RECOMMENDED. A SOLVENT IMPERVIOUS APRON IS RECOMMENDED IF BODY CONTACT MAY OCCUR.

WORK/HYGIENIC PRACTICES:

WASH CONTAMINATED CLOTHING BEFORE REUSE. PERIODIC MONITORING OF EXPOSURE LEVELS/LIMITS IS RECOMMENDED.
